

Advice for Small Business Coaching Participant

Self-Employment Rental Assistance is a fixed rate payment available to eligible Small Business Coaching Participants. It is paid for up to 26 weeks from the date you start receiving Self-Employment Allowance.

To be eligible for Self-Employment Rental Assistance, you must:

- be receiving Rent Assistance from Services Australia (Centrelink) or the Department of Veterans' Affairs (DVA) on the day immediately before you start receiving Self-Employment Allowance; and
- be receiving Rent Assistance under your current income support payment or pension, NOT as part of a Family Allowance payment.

Your Centrelink or DVA Rent Assistance will cease if you start receiving Self-Employment Rental Assistance.

To claim Self-Employment Rental Assistance:

- Take this form to a Centrelink or DVA office for completion. Make sure they stamp the form.
- Return your completed form to your Self-Employment Assistance Provider or upload your completed form using the Workforce Australia website.
